⁺The Center for Irish Music (CIM) has been leasing space from the Celtic Junction Ilc. since 2009. Upon the completion of this project, the CIM will begin a new long-term lease agreement for seven years with two five-year renewals. The terms of the lease agreement state that CIM will pay for 100% of the improvement costs. Naming rights will remain in place for the 17-year duration of the lease.
